<u>HOWEVER</u>, IF YOU FILL THAT APPLICATION OUT, MAIL IT IN, AND DO NOT FULFILL YOUR CE REQUIREMENTS, YOU ARE BREAKING THE LAW. IF YOU ARE AUDITED AND YOU HAVE NOT FULFILLED YOUR CE REQUIREMENTS YOU COULD BE BROUGHT UP ON CHARGES AND FINED FOR DOING THIS BY THE MICHIGAN BOARD OF DENTISTRY.

Trustee Report/HOD Report 2012

The Michigan Dental Hygienists' Association 31st Annual House of Delegates took place on October 19-21 in Traverse City. Macomb was well represented and I would like to thank our Delegates, Stephanie Pepka, Mary Spatafora, Becky Domagalski, Debora Szymanski, Kim Amico, and Donna Szymanski on a job well done. There were 4 Bylaws and 14 Resolutions. You can go to MDHAtoday.org for current bylaws and resolutions. The Bylaw that I would like to inform you all about is Life Members are now required to pay 50% of their state dues whereas before they didn't pay state dues this was something that had a lot of discussion. Our delegates also voted on new officers and delegates to ADHA.

We recognized Stephanie Pepka as our Hygienist of the Year for Macomb and Sandy Franklin got the Life Member Award to MDHA. Congratulations to the both of them.

The University of Detroit Mercy did a presentation on a pilot program: The Restorative Dental Hygienist at the HOD meeting. There will be a pilot program starting at the University that will give an RDH training to place Class I fillings such as occlusal amalgam fillings. There is still more research being done on this program and they did not specify a date when this will be starting.

Overall HOD went well and smoothly. MDHA will be celebrating its 90th Anniversary next year. There will be a celebration happening at HOD 2013 which will be in Lansing October 18-20, 2013. I encourage you all to come and celebrate being part of your profession.

ADHA Annual Meeting will be in Boston next year which we will be celebrating the 100th Anniversary of ADHA on June 17-27^{th 2013}.

I just attended the BOT meeting on December 9th, 2012. It was a combined meeting with Trustees and Council Chairs. We reviewed MDHA Strategic Plan and made necessary changes which will be found on the MDHA website. We will be making revisions to the Policy and Procedure Manual if anybody wants to make necessary changes please let me know; again these can be found on website under members section.

MDHA is currently researching to makeup a bill to let RDH give prescriptions such as fluoride and chlorhexidine and possible prophylactic antibiotics; research still needs to be done on this before we go forward.

MDHA is in need of an Editor; also next year a new Treasurer and VP is needed so this would be a great time to be more involved in your association.

MDHA received a legislative grant of \$5000. That will be used for legislative blitz, luncheon and other needs.

We will be doing more Poker tournaments to help MDHA next one is at Big Beaver Tavern will be In August 23-26^{th 2013}. MDHA will continue the coffee sales next year. This year's profit was \$817. BOT also decided to sell RDH rhinestone pins as a fundraiser.

MDHA Legislative Blitz will be on February 13th 2013. MDHA Legislative Luncheon will be on May 8th 2013.

MDA/MDHA Joint Session will be on April 18-19th 2013 in Novi, MI
