Dr. Johnston attended Michigan State University to major in Microbiology. He received his DDS in 1982 and a Masters Degree in Periodontology in 1986 from the University of Michigan. He began his academic career as an Assistant Professor at Nagasaki University School of Dentistry in Nagasaki, Japan.

Dr. Johnston is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and a Fellow in the American College of Dentists, International College of Dentists, Pierre Fauchard Academy and International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He is a certified dental editor and is the past Editor of the Journal of the Michigan Dental Association, past president of the Macomb Dental Society, the Michigan Periodontal Association, and the Michigan Dental Association. Dr. Johnston currently serves as Trustee to the American Academy of Periodontology and is a member of the Journal Review Committee. He is the author of numerous scientific publications and has lectured extensively on the topics of Periodontics and Implant Dentistry.

Dr. Johnston maintains a private practice limited to Periodontics and Implant Dentistry. He is also Adjunct Clinical Assistant Professor / Dean's Faculty at the University of Michigan, School of Dentistry, Department of Oral Medicine and Periodontology.
